Optional Activity

Bible Focus: Noah and the flood.

Verse: I am God Almighty, walk before me and be blameless. Genesis 17:1

The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Cloud cutout

Cotton balls

6 colored

strips

Glue sticks

*Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned about how there was a time people on Earth did not know about God. **But** God could see them. He did not like what he saw. The people were selfish and evil. God wanted to put an end to all people. Noah was a good man. God went to Noah and told him he was going to flood the earth and to build a great ark for himself and his family. God told Noah to bring 2 of every animal with him. It rained for 40 days. Noah sent out a dove to see if the flood was gone. The dove brought back a twig from an olive tree. Noah waited 7 days and sent the dove again. This time the dove did not come back because he found dry ground. God put a rainbow in the sky to show Noah the promise he made to him that he would never flood the earth again.

Give each child a cloud cutout, some cotton balls and one streamer of each color in the rainbow. Have them glue the cotton balls around the outside of the cloud. Next have them glue the colored streamers to the back of the bottom of the cloud. **This rainbow is represents the rainbow God made appear in the sky to remind Noah of his promise!**
