*The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

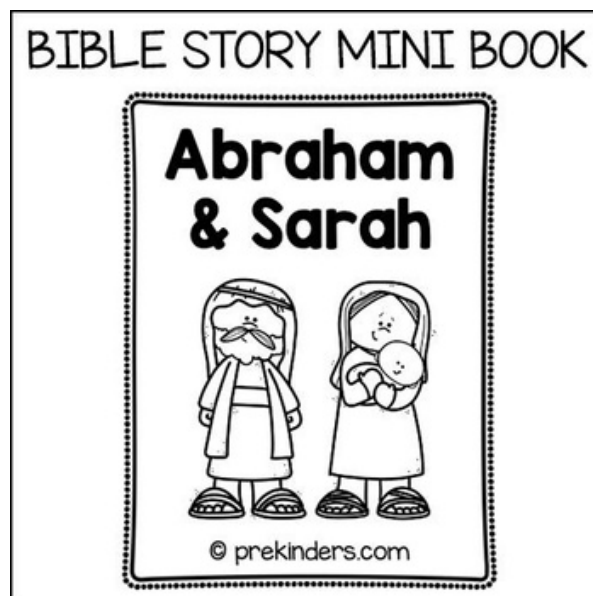
**Supplies
