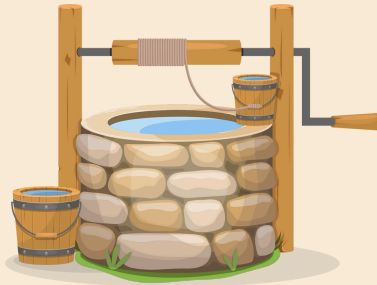

Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Joseph as a Boy

Verse: Serve the Lord with all your heart. 1 Samuel 12:20

Bible Point: God cares for us all the time.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Josephs Coat
Coloring

Paper strips

Glue

Today we learned about Jacob and how he had a favorite son named Joseph. Jacob gave Joseph a coat of many colors and it made Josephs brothers very jealous because of all the attention he was receiving from their dad. Joseph had dreams about wheat and the sun and moon. These dreams stood for his brothers bowing down to Joseph. One day Josephs brothers threw him into a hole but they did not leave him there for long. Give each child a Joseph coat printout. Set out the precut paper strips. Let each child glue paper strips onto their sheet to decorate Josephs colorful coat!



Activity Option 2

Popsicle stick

Colors/markers

Glue sticks

Give each child a pit cutout, a Joseph cutout and a popsicle stick.

Have them color/decorate the pit and Joseph cutout however they choose. Next have them glue the Joseph cutout onto the popsicle stick and inset into the pre cut slit in the pit. Have them move the stick up and down to look like Joseph is falling into the pit.
