Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Joseph Serves God all His Life. **Verse:** Serve the Lord with all your heart. 1 Samuel 12:20 **Bible Point:** God cares for us all the time.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Pharaoh headpiece paper

Headband strip
Stapler/ Tape

Crayons/
Markers

Today we learned that Joseph was alive in Egypt. The traders had sold him to a rich family where Joseph did very well because God was with him. In time, Joseph became very powerful in Egypt, second only to Pharaoh the King. One day, a family of brothers from another land came before Joseph. The men were Joseph's brothers. They were worried Joseph would punish them for what they had done but he said " Do not be afraid because of what you did to me. It was not you who sent me here, but God."

Give each child a headpiece printout, have them color the headpiece however they would like! Help them attach the headpiece strip using a stapler or tape to fit their head! This headpiece is to remind us that God provided for Joseph in Egypt making him powerful next to the King.



Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: Joseph Serves God all His Life.

Verse: Serve the Lord with all your heart. 1 Samuel 12:20

Bible Point: God cares for us all the time.

The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Today we learned that **Pharaoh** made **Joseph** a ruler over Egypt because he explained his dream. God provided for **Joseph** even when he was in jail.

Help the children color the three scenes. Once complete, fold the scenes along the dotted lines to form a triangle with the scenes showing on the outside. Tape the tab on scene 3 to the back of scene 1 so that the pyramid stands on its own. Children can use the pyramids to retell the story of Joseph serving God:

Who got Joseph out of prison to interpret his dream? (**Pharaoh**) What did Joseph tell Pharaoh his dream meant? (He said they need to grow lots of food and save it because there will be no rain.) What did Pharaoh do with Joseph after this? (He made him a ruler over Egypt) Who ended up coming to Egypt, where Joseph was able to give them food? (**Joseph's brothers**)
