There was a very strong man named Samson. God had chosen him to save the Israelites from their enemies, the Philistines.

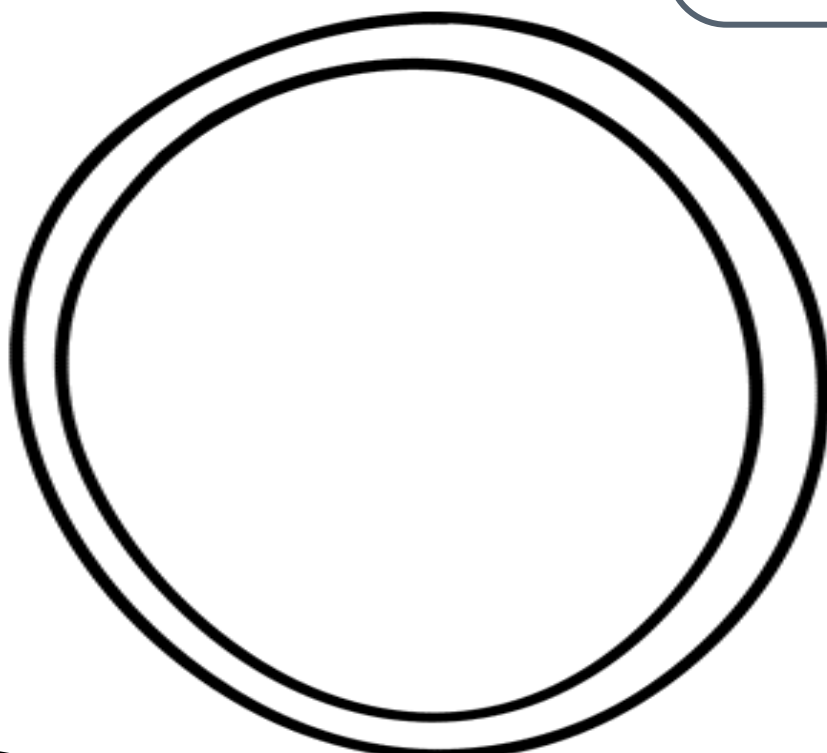
