Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: John The Baptist

The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

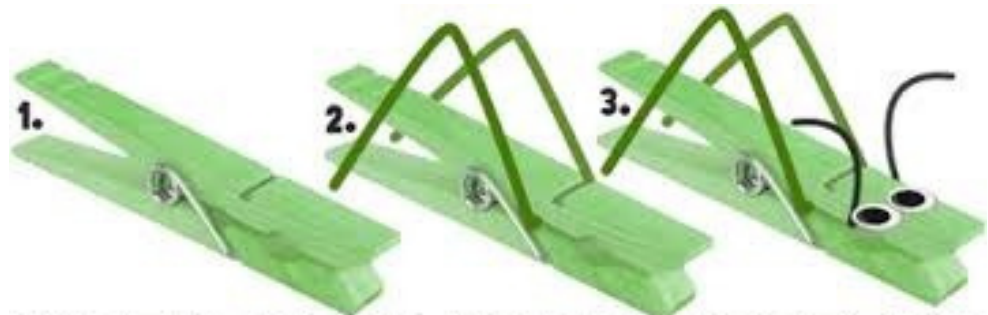
Supplies Needed:

Clothespin
Green Paint
Googly eyes
Green pipecleaner

Today we learned about Jesus' cousin named John! John was a prophet and told everyone he knew that Jesus was coming and that HE was our Lord and Savior! We learned that John lived in the desert and ate locusts and wild honey from bees to survive! Today we are going to make a locust to show all that John did to spread the word of the Gospel.

Have each child paint a clothespin green. Then give each child a green pipe cleaner and bend it to make the legs for the grasshopper like shown in the picture (tape or glue if needed). Then have each child glue on two eyes for the grasshopper to see!



Activity Option 2

Have each child paint a clothespin yellow and add black stripes. The give each child a black pipe cleaner for antennas, help the child glue or take them on the back). Then give each child a pair of black wings and tape or glue it to the back of the pipe cleaner. Then have each child glue on two eyes for the bee to see!
