# Activity Option 1

**Bible Focus:** Samson defeats the Philistines

**Verse:** For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10

**Bible Point:** God made you for a reason

## Supplies Needed:

Paper sheet cutout

3 Samson cutouts

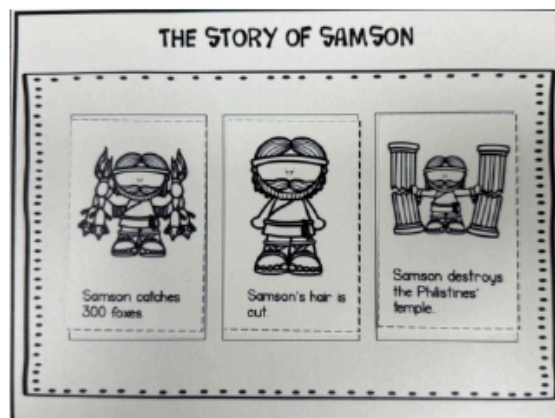
Crayons/Markers

Glue

Today we learned about **Samson** and how he was a very strong man. **Samson** was in love with **Delilah** but she was paid by the **Philistines** to be a spy to find out what made **Samson** so strong. **Samson** trusted **Delilah** and told her that if you cut his hair, he would lose his strength. When he was asleep the **Philistines** cut his hair and he lost his strength. **Samson** prayed to **God** to make him strong one last time and he pushed the temple down. **God** gave **Samson** his strength.

Give each child story of Samson paper and the 3 cutouts. Have them color the cutouts however they would like. Help them place the cutouts in order according to the story of Samson.



# Activity Option 2
