# Activity Option 1

**Bible Focus:** Samuel as a Boy

**Verse:** Serve the Lord with all your heart. 1 Samuel 12:20

**Bible Point:** God uses His people to care for us.

The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

## Supplies Needed:

Headband paper strips

Left ear cutout

Right ear cutout

Bible verse cutout

Stapler/tape

Crayons/markers

\*Say the words in BOLD

Today we learned that Samuel's mother, Hannah, prayed to God each year asking for a child. Hannah promised God that her son would dedicate his life to the Lord. God heard Hannah's prayers and gave her a son. When Samuel was older, he listened to God's voice and His teachings! One night Samuel was asleep. He woke up to the sound of someone calling his name. He went to Eli and said "here I am" but Eli did not call his name. Samuel heard this again but Eli told him it was not him calling his name. On the third time Eli knew it was God speaking to Samuel and told him to go back to sleep and if he heard it again to say "I'm listening Lord, What do you want me to do." Samuel did as instructed when he heard his name again. From then on Samuel became a prophet of God.

Give each child the headband strip of paper, a left and right ear cutout, and a Bible verse cutout. Let the children color their ears and bible verse cutout however they choose. When they are done, staple/tape the headband strip together. Help them glue their bible verse cutout to the middle of the strips. Glue the ears onto each side. When they are done gluing, measure their head using their headbands and staple/tape the strips together so that each child can wear their headbands!



# Activity Option 2

## Bible Focus: Samuel as a Boy

### Supplies Needed:

Coloring Sheet

Small rectangle cut out

Large rectangle cutout

Glue sticks

Verse sticker

Crayons/markers

Give each child one small rectangle cut out and one large rectangle cut out. Have them color both cutouts however they would like. Have them glue the smaller rectangle cutout onto the dotted line at the top of the larger rectangle cut out. Next have them stick the bible verse sticker on the backside of smaller rectangle cut out (as shown in the picture below). Help the children glue and line up the rectangles if needed. They can flip the rectangles open and shut to look like Samuel is waking up and talking with God.
