Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: The Brave Queen

Bible Point: God made you for a reason

Today we learned that about the law of the land in Bible times. The queen could not go and speak to her husband the king. She had to gain permission. Give each child an Esther sheet and a few q-tips. Set out the water and let the children water paint Esther. When they are done, have them trace the letters at the bottom of the page with crayon/markers!



Activity Option 2
