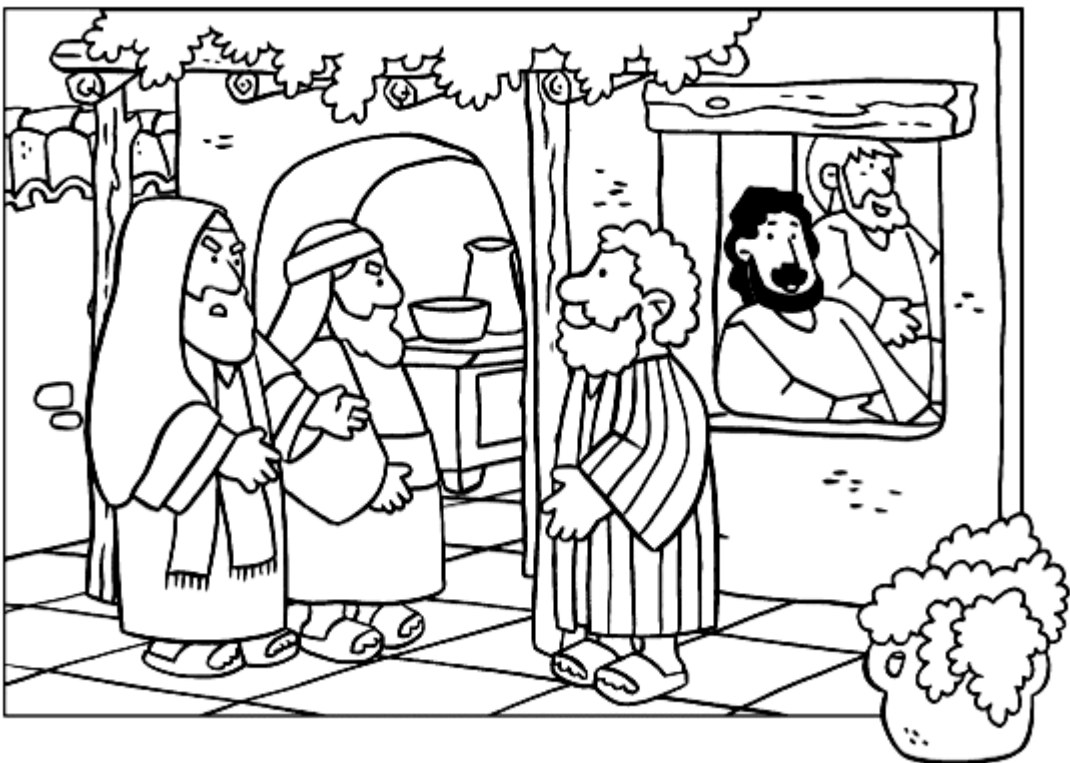
BIBLE STORY
