Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Jesus Is Tempted

Verse: “Jesus increased in wisdom...and in favor with God.” Luke 2:52

Bible Point: : God’s Word helps us do what is right.

The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Sand


Q-Tips

Today we learned about how Jesus was in a hot and lonely desert for 40 days and 40 nights. The whole time he didn't eat anything...he spent his time praying to God. Satan came to visit Jesus and tried tempting him to sin. Jesus stayed strong and stayed true to God. When Jesus was tempted to sin, he quoted a Bible verse. Jesus pleased God!

Today we are going to make a bear. This bear is to remind us that God is faithful and that he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can BEAR!! The sand we will put on the bear is to remind us of Jesus being in the desert for 40 days and 40 nights.



Activity Option 2

Give each child a pre-made book and a crayon/marker. Have all the kids sit down at the table and listen carefully! Talk to them about what temptation is and then go page by page of the book talking about whether each topic on the page would make God happy or sad. Have them color the smiley face if happy and the sad face if sad. Talk about each topic and discuss why it would make God happy or sad. Once you have gone through each page of the book you can have the kids go back through and color their pages if that want!
