Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Jesus Heals the Soldier's Servant

Verse: "Our Lord is great and very powerful." Psalm 147:5

Bible Point: : Jesus has the power to heal people.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Shield Cut-out

Construction Paper

Glue Sticls

Crayons/ Markers

*Say the words in BOLD

Today we learned about a Soldier who needed Jesus' help. He went to Jesus and told him about his servant who was sick and he wanted Him to heal him. The soldier did not want Jesus to come to his house because he felt he was not good enough to have the Lord in his home. Jesus said he would heal him and by his words alone He healed the servant!

Today we are going to make a shield to remind us of the Soldier and how Jesus healed his servant!

Give each child a shield cutout and let them color it. When they are done have them glue their shield cutout onto the piece of construction paper.
