As you color the picture talk about how at that moment the soldier was healed.

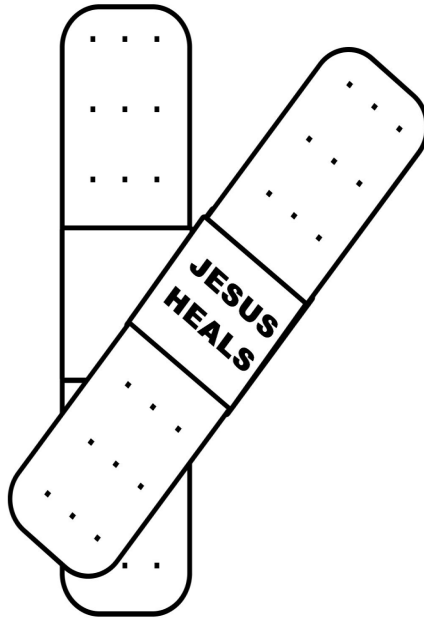

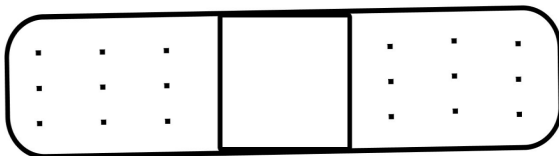
A MIRACLE WORKER

FAMILY FUN
