


Jesus Heals a Man Who Could Not Walk

Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Jesus Heals a Man Who Could Not Walk

Verse: "Our Lord is great and very powerful." Psalm 147:5

Bible Point: : Jesus can do great things.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Rectangle Scene

Strip Scene

Markers/ Crayons *Say the words in BOLD

Today we learn about a man who could not walk. Jesus helped and healed him! We're going to make a reminder about how Jesus healed the crippled man.

Today we are going to make a craft that can move so we can show the scene through pictures!

Give each child a rectangle scene and have them color the scene. The paper should already be pre-cut for the child. Then give the child the strip scene and have them color it. When both are colored in, please help them all thread the strip scene through and show them how it works!



Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: Jesus Heals a Man Who Could Not Walk

Verse: "Our Lord is great and very powerful." Psalm 147:5

Bible Point: : Jesus can do great things!

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Popsicle Sticks (2 per child)

Cardstock Rectangl

> Man Cut Out

> > Brads

Crayons & Markers

*Say the words in BOLD

Today we learn about a man who could not walk. Jesus helped and healed him! We're going to make a reminder about how Jesus healed the crippled man.

Give each child 2 popsicle sticks, a cardstock piece, and a man cut out. Why did the men want to take their friend to see Jesus? (They heard that Jesus had the power to heal their friend.) What did the friends use to lower the man down from the roof? (A mat and some ropes)

Have them glue the rectangle to the 2 popsicle sticks to make a mat. Let them color their man however they choose. **We're going to make our mat for our man to lay on.**

Help each student attach the brad so that the man can move positions on the cardstock. What did Jesus say to the man lying on the mat? (Get Up! Pick up your mat and go on home!) Everyone lets move our man like he has gotten up!

What did the people say after they watched the man get up and walk? (We have seen a miracle today.)
