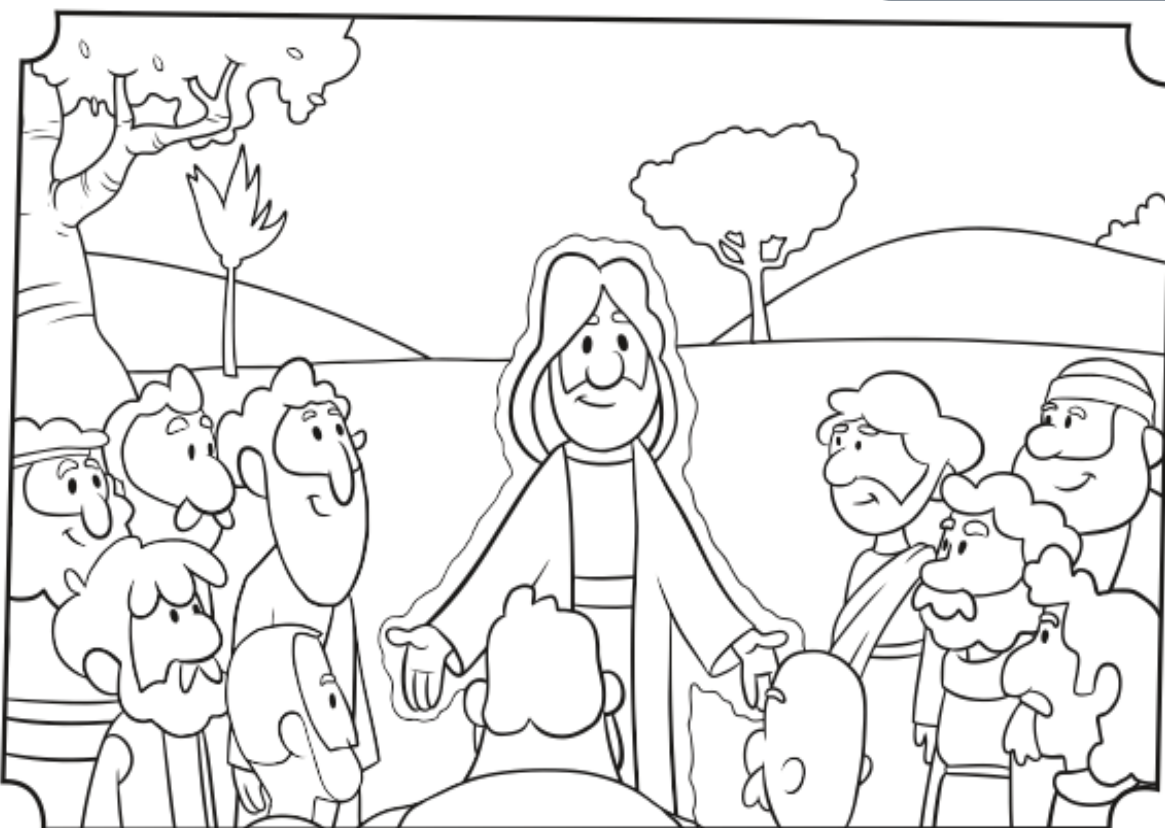
"Do not be afraid," the angel said. "Jesus is alive— just as He said He would be!"

As you color the picture, talk about how Jesus' friends felt after finding out Jesus was alive.



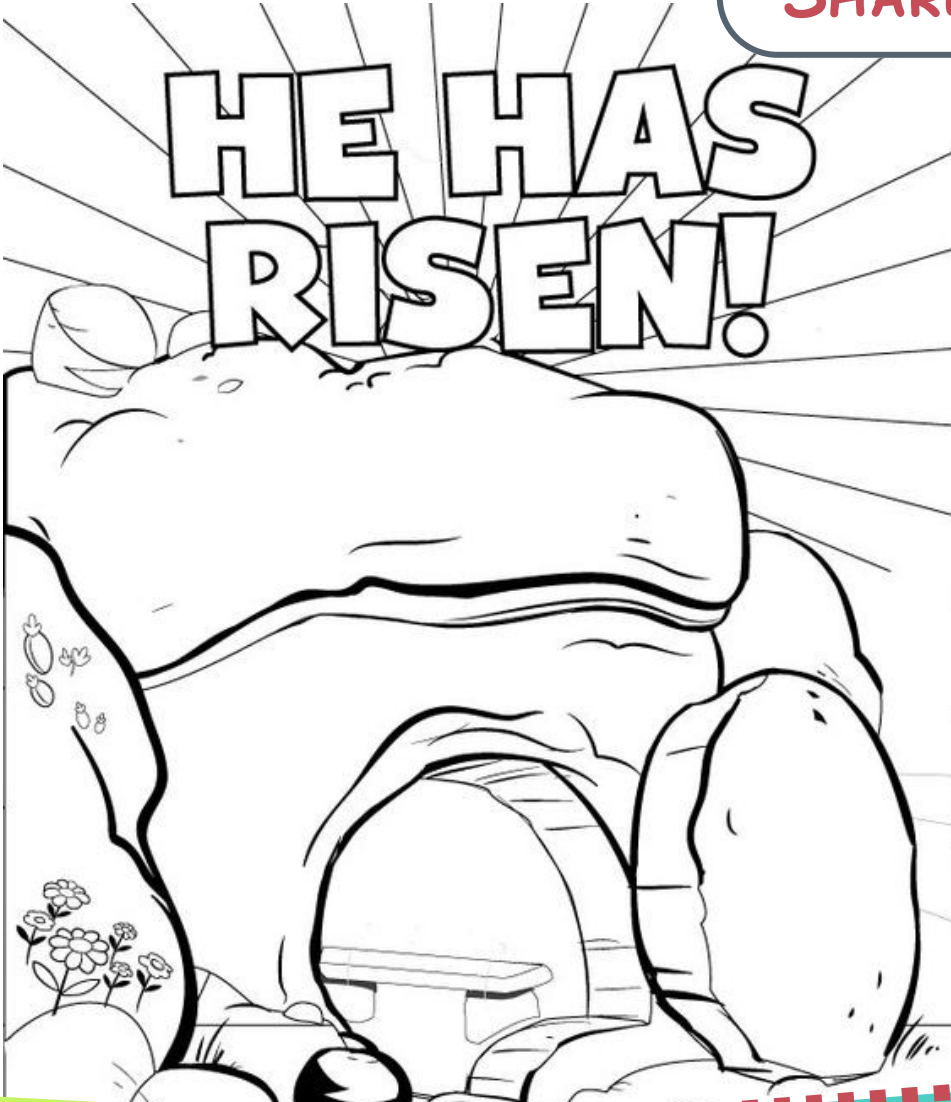
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SHARE THE NEWS
