BIBLE STORY

From 1 Kings 17:1-6

One day God sent the prophet Elijah to see King Ahab. Elijah said, "King Ahab, you have not obeyed God. God wants you to know there will be no rain in the land for a few years."

God knew the king would be angry. God told Elijah to go and hide by a brook. God said He would take care of Elijah.

Elijah obeyed and did just as God told him. Every day birds came with bread and meat for Elijah to eat. Every day Elijah drank water from the brook. God cared for Elijah.

FAMILY TALK

In this week's Bible lesson, your child learned that God provided food for Elijah, but God provides so much more! It is important to remember to thank God and praise Him for His care.

Take a walk and ask your child to name things God made. Ask questions such as,

"How does God use the sun to take care of us?"

Or, "Does God use rain to help us? How?"

When going to the grocery store, stop and look at items, such as a sack of flour, a favorite fresh vegetable or fruit, or a jug of milk. Ask, "Where does milk come from?", "Who made the cows?"

Using basic yet stimulating questions, you can help your child recognize and be thankful for God's daily care.

FAMILY FUN...

Feed the Birds.... Help your child remember the ravens God used to help feed Elijah. Provide a pinecone with a string looped around the top. Spread peanut butter on a plate and roll the pinecone in the peanut butter. Pour birdseed onto a second plate and roll the peanut butter-coated pinecone in the birdseed. Hang the prepared pinecone on a tree outside your home and enjoy watching the birds that come to eat!
