Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: The Jailer Follows Jesus

Verse: “Tell the Good News to everyone!” Mark 16:15

Bible Point: : We can sing and tell about Jesus

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Paul and Silas
Coloring
Pages

Yarn

Glue

*Say the words in BOLD

Today we learned how the Lord freed Paul and Silas. We talked about how the jailer came to know Jesus as his personal Lord. Some men got mad at them because they did not want to hear what they were saying about Jesus. They threw Paul and Silas in jail but at midnight there was a huge earthquake and the jail doors broke open and the chains fell off the prisoners! The jailer was so scared he would be hurt because he lost prisoners but Paul and Silas told the jailer all about Jesus and that he would be saved!

Give each child a coloring sheet and 5 pieces of cut yarn. Have them color their picture using crayons or markers. Next have them glue a few pieces of string over the cutout to make them look like Paul and Silas are in jail.



Activity Option 2

Today we are going to make a chain to remind us that God is with us always! Give each child one strip of each colored paper. Help them tape/staple their strips together to make a chain representing Paul and Silas in jail and how they helped the jailer follow Jesus! Their chain should say “I am with you always”
