Supplies Needed:

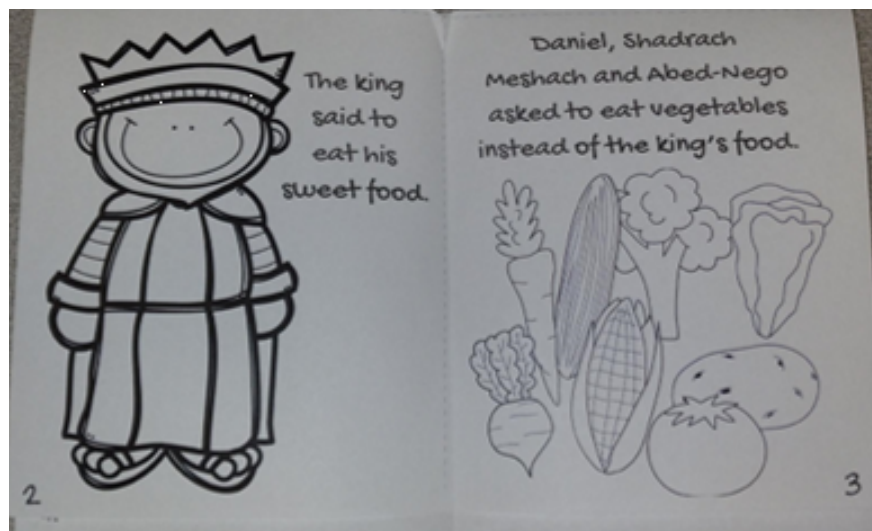
Book printout

Activity Option 2

Printout

Veggie
Cutouts

Glue sticks

Today we learned about 4 young men who pleased God by obeying Him and keeping their bodies healthy. We’re going to make a craft to remind us to keep our bodies healthy too.

Pass out a plate printout to each child. Lay out the different vegetable cutouts and let them each pick a few and glue them onto their plate. They can color their plate and silverware if they choose!

As they decorate everything, review the bible story with them.

What did Daniel not want to do? (Eat the king’s food)

What did he want to do instead? (Eat food pleasing to God)

Did the guard allow them to eat what they wanted? (Yes for 10 days)

**What happened after 10 days?
(Daniel and his friends were healthier than the rest of the men)**

**What kinds of foods should you eat?
(Healthy food – fruits and vegetables and things that grow in the ground)**
