Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Elijah Helps a Widow

Verse: “Thank the Lord because He is good. His love continues forever.” Psalm 107:1

Bible Point: : God wants us to obey Him.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Jar Picture

Watercolors

Q-tips

Cup of Water

Today we learned about a sad widow who needed money to pay off her husbands debts. Elisha asked what she had and she said a jar of oil. Elisha told her to borrow empty bottles from neighbors. God was going to fill these empty jars with oil so that she could sell them and make money. A miracle happened because the oil did not run out, it kept filling the jars!

Give each child a jar picture and have them use the q-tips to paint their jar however they choose to decorate it. This jar is to remind us that God will always provide for us and be there for us when we need him!

Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: Elijah Helps a Widow

Supplies Needed:

Jug Cutout

Flour Bag Cutout

Oil Jar Cutout

Hole Punch String

Colors/
Markers

Today we learned how God told Elijah to tell the widow woman not to worry about not having any food and to go home and make bread for her son, Elijah and herself. The jug of flour and oil would never run dry. It is so amazing how God can perform such amazing miracles!

Give each child a jug cutout, a flour bag cutout and a oil jar cutout. Let them color all 3 however they choose. When they are done help them use the hole punch to make a whole in each 3 sheet. Help them attach the string through all 3 holes and tie the string together to secure the papers.

This craft is to remind us that God continued to fill the widows oil and flour so she could continue to make bread!
