2 Prayer Wheel Cutouts

Crayons/ Markers

Paper Brad Fastener

Today we learned about how Elijah was staying with a widow, the same woman who gave him a drink and bread. The woman had a son who got terribly sick and died. Elijah told the woman to hand the boy to him and he took him upstairs to his own bed. Elijah prayed and asked God to heal the boy. God listened to Elijahs prayer. They boy began to breath...he was alive again!

We can pray and talk to God about anything. God hears us when we pray because of His great love for us!

Today we are going to make a prayer wheel about different places we can pray! It doesn't matter where we are when we pray because God hears us wherever we pray!

Give each child one of each piece of the praying wheel. Let them color each piece however they choose. When they are done help them place the full circle on the bottom and then the circle with the shape cut out on the top. Help them attach the two together using a paper



brad fastener. They can turn the top piece around and see all the different places they can pray!
