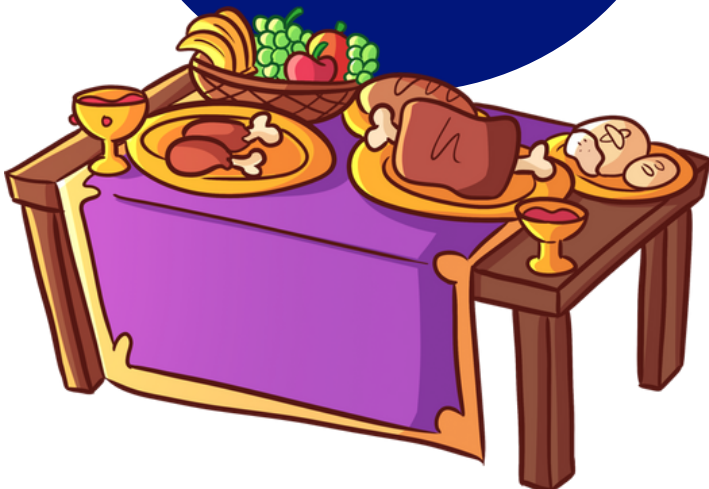




Daniel and the Handwriting on the Wall

Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Daniel and the Handwriting on the Wall

Verse: “With all my heart I try to obey you, God. Don’t let me break your commands.” Psalm 119:10

Bible Point: : We can tell others about God.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies Needed:

Coloring Sheet

Watercolors

Q-tips

Cups of water

*Say the words in BOLD

Today we learned about how King Belshazzar had a dinner party with 1,000 guest who all worshipped idols. They did not worship the one true God. Suddenly a big hand appeared and wrote some words that the king could not understand on the palace wall. Then the hand disappeared. No one knew what the words meant so the King sent for Daniel because he knew Daniel worshiped God and could help. Daniel told the King that God knew he was not obeying or worshipping Him and that the words on the wall meant that God would punish the King by taking away his kingdom. God helped Daniel to be brave and wise.

Give each child a coloring sheet and a few Q-Tips. Set out some cups of water and water color paints. Let them paint their coloring sheet however they choose!



Activity Option 2
