Activity Option 1

Lion's Head Cutout

Lion's Body Cutout

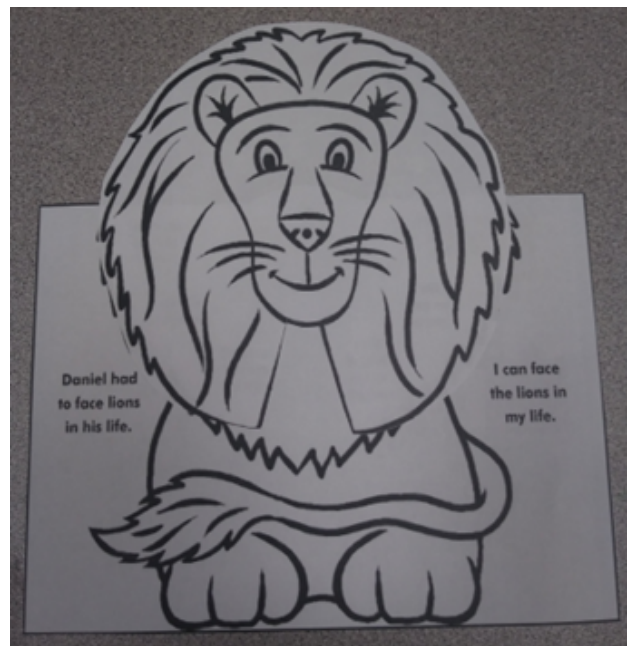
Paper Fastener

Crayons/Markers

Today we learned about how King Darius chose Daniel to rule over all the **governors**. Some of the other men were not happy about this decision and went to the King and told him he should make a law that said it was against the law to pray to any other god or man but the king. The King agreed and signed the law. Daniel was caught praying to God and had to be punished. The king knew he was tricked by these men but Daniel had to be thrown into the Lions Den. The next morning King Darius went to the pit and found Daniel was healthy and waiting to come out. Daniel told the the Lord had sent an angel to keep the lions from eating Daniel. From that day on the King believed in the **one true God!**

Give each child a lion head cutout and a lion body cutout. Have them color both pieces however they choose. When they are done help them insert a paper fastener through the dot on the lion's nose and through the dot on the lion's body cutout and fasten on the back. They can now move the lion's head to see the different ways they can obey God the way that Daniel did!
