
What Is The Bible?

Bible Story

John 1:1

The Bible is a special book written many, many years ago by God's chosen people. God chose prophets and followers to write down messages He wanted to deliver to His people. These messages are of His love, His power, and His faithfulness. These messages also told them how to live their lives as God's children. Ultimately, God's messages—also known as God's Word—reveals Who He is. His Word is the Bible!

God sent His Son, Jesus, to live out His Word as a human. We can trust that His Word is true because we believe in the God who wrote it!

Find three truths about God's WordThe Bible.

Examples:

"God's Word is true." "God spoke His Word to people." "The Bible is God's Word." Say these truths out loud and see if your child can remember them and say them back to you.

Find a Bible in your home that is simpler to understand, such as a kid's Adventure Bible. Show your child how the Bible is made of many books, written by different people at different times in history. Tell them that even though different people wrote the Bible, God was the original author– He gave the words to them to write. Ask if your child knows how the Bible was originally written–on paper scrolls! It was later compiled into the Bible that we use today.

Family challenge:

Give each family member a verse of scripture to look up in the Bible. If your child or any other family members need help, you can team up. Once they find the verse, have them read it aloud. Remind them that God spoke these words through His messengers and prophets long ago!


