Bible Verse:

Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: God made the Heavens & Earth/ Water & Sky

Verse: "God created the heaven and the Earth" Genesis

1:1

Bible Point: God made light, the earth, and the sky.

The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies:

- -Construction Paper
- -Cotton Balls
- -Blue Tissue Paper
- -Bible Verse Sticker
- -Glue stick

*Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned about how on the first day God separated the light and the darkness. We're going to make something to help us remember what happened on Day 1!

Give each child a piece of black construction paper. Have the children glue the blue half sheet of paper on the black paper diagonally (it is now half black and half blue).

Give

each child some cotton balls, a sun and moon die cut, star stickers, and glue sticks. Have them glue the cotton balls and the Sun on the blue side. Then have then glue the moon and the stars on the black side. Lastly give each child a sticker with the bible verse on it to attach to their sheets wherever they choose!



Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: God made the Heavens & Earth/ Water & Sky

Verse: "God created the heaven and the Earth" Genesis 1:1

Bible Point: "The Beginning"

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies:

- -Wax Paper Circle
- -Black Half Circle
- -Yellow Tissue Paper
- -Glue Sticks
- -Bible Verse Sticker

*Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned about how on the first day God separated the light and the darkness. We're going to make something to help us remember what happened on Day 1!

Give each child a wax circle. Have them glue on the black half circle. On the wax paper side have each child glue on the yellow tissue paper to look like light. When finished, have the child stick on the bible verse sicker on the black side.
