



# God Made Land, Plants, and Trees/ 2 Great Lights

## PRESCHOOL LESSON

### Bible Point:

God made light,  
the earth, and  
sky.

### Bible Verse:

“God created  
the Heaven  
and the Earth.”  
Genesis 1:1

# Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: God Made Land, Plants, and Trees

Verse: “God said, let the dry land appear and the earth produce vegetation, plants and trees.” Genesis 1:9-11

Bible Point: God created everything!

*The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

## Supplies:

-Paper Plate

-Green  
Crayons

-Arm/Hand  
Cutout

-Glue Stick

-Bible Verse  
Sticker

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

**Today we learned about how on the 3rd day God created the land, plants and trees. Our craft today is to remind us that God created all of this with his hands!**

Give each child a paper plate, an arm/hand cutout and green crayons. Let them decorate the paper plate to look like a tree. Next have them glue their arm/hand cutout onto the paper plate to look like a tree trunk. Lastly have them attach a Bible verse sticker onto their tree wherever they choose!



# Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: God Made Two Great Lights, the Sun and the Moon

Verse: "God made two great lights..." Genesis 1:16

Bible Point: God created everything!

*The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

## Supplies:

-Blue Paper

-Yellow,  
Orange,  
Gray, White  
Paint

-Sponges

-Q-Tips

-Bible Verse  
Sticker

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

**Today we learned about how on the 4th day God created the Sun and the Moon. He created the Sun to rule over the day. He created the moon and the stars to rule over the night.**

Give each child a blue sheet of paper. Have them use the sponge in the yellow paint to stamp a sun on their light blue sheet of paper. Next let them use a Q-tip to dip in orange paint to help create the sun's rays. Next have them use the sponge in gray paint to create the moon. Let them use a Q-tip to dip in white paint to create the moon's crater. They can also use a Q-tip to create stars around the moon with white paint. Lastly have them attach a Bible verse sticker on to their creation!
