Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: God Made People

Verse: "Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness."

Genesis 2:26

Bible Point: God made people and rested.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.




2 Sided Worksheet

Crayons/ Markers *Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned that on the 6th day God also made people. God said, "Let us make man in our likeness. Let them take care of all the creatures." On the 7th day, He rested. Let's do an activity that reminds us how God wants us to rest on the 7th day, too! This day is called the "Sabbath".

Hand each child a worksheet and guide them through it if needed, using crayons or markers. Discuss why God considers it important for us to rest just as He did. Talk about how this rest (or Sabbath) day is beneficial to our souls.





Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: God Rested.

Verse: God blessed the seventh day and declared it holy, for on it He

rested from His work of creation. Genesis 2:3

Bible Point: God made people and rested.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies:

Construction Paper

Church Cutout

Door Cutout

People Cutout

Bible Verse Cutout

Glue Stick

Crayons/ Markers *Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned that on the seventh day everything was made and God rested. He made day 7 to be the day when we worship and learn about Him with other Christians. We call this holy day, Sunday! Our craft today is to remind us of all the things we can see that God made.

Give each child a sheet of construction paper, a church cutout, door cutout and people cutout. Have them first glue the church onto their paper. Next have them glue the doors to the front of the church in the outlined portion. If they want to color their people cutout they can, then have them glue it on their sheet. Lastly, give them a Bible verse cutout to glue to the top of their sheet! If they want to add any decorations to their church allow them to do so using crayons/markers!
