# Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Moses Is Born

Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord and pray to Him." Psalm 105:1

Bible Point: God knows about our troubles.

White Paper  
with River

Crayons/  
Markers

Glue Sticks

Baby Moses

Cupcake  
Liners

**Today we learned that Moses's mommy loved him so much that she did the most loving and greatest thing she could for him. She made a basket and set him sailing away to save his life. She trusted God to do something great and He did just that. The Pharoah's daughter found Moses and raised him as her own. Only God could make something like this happen! God took care of Moses!**

Hand each child a piece of paper and ask them to color the grass and the Nile river. Hand them a baby Moses and ask them to color him. Hand them a cupcake paper and glue stick. First they need to glue Moses in their cupcake paper. Second, glue the cupcake paper in the river on their paper.



# Activity Option 2

Give each child a river cutout, a baby Moses cutout and a popsicle stick. Have them color both cutouts however they choose. When they are done have them glue or tape baby Moses onto the popsicle stick. Next have them insert the popsicle stick into the cutout slot on the river so they can move the basket around to make it look like Moses is floating down the river.
