BIBLE STORY

From Genesis 12:1-9

The Bible tells us that God told a man named Abram to leave his home. Abram loved God, so he did what God said.

FAMILY FUN

FOLLOWING THE LEADER.

Have the family form a line and take turns being the leader. The leader will lead the group in a variety of activities around the house or yard. Sample activities: hopping on one foot, touching your finger to your nose, stretching your arms out like an airplane, and so on. After everyone has had a turn, talk about how Jesus is our leader and we are to follow Him.

Children spend much more time at home than at the church. You are one of your child's most important teachers. Your willingness to invest time and effort in your child's life during these early, impressionable years will pay off as you see your child learning to respond to the world in ways that are pleasing to God. Parenting is tough work! Remember to rely on God and follow His leading. Demonstrate throughout your day that you are a follower of Jesus! Little eyes and ears are watching and listening. We, as parents, are to live our lives on mission for Christ in front of our children.

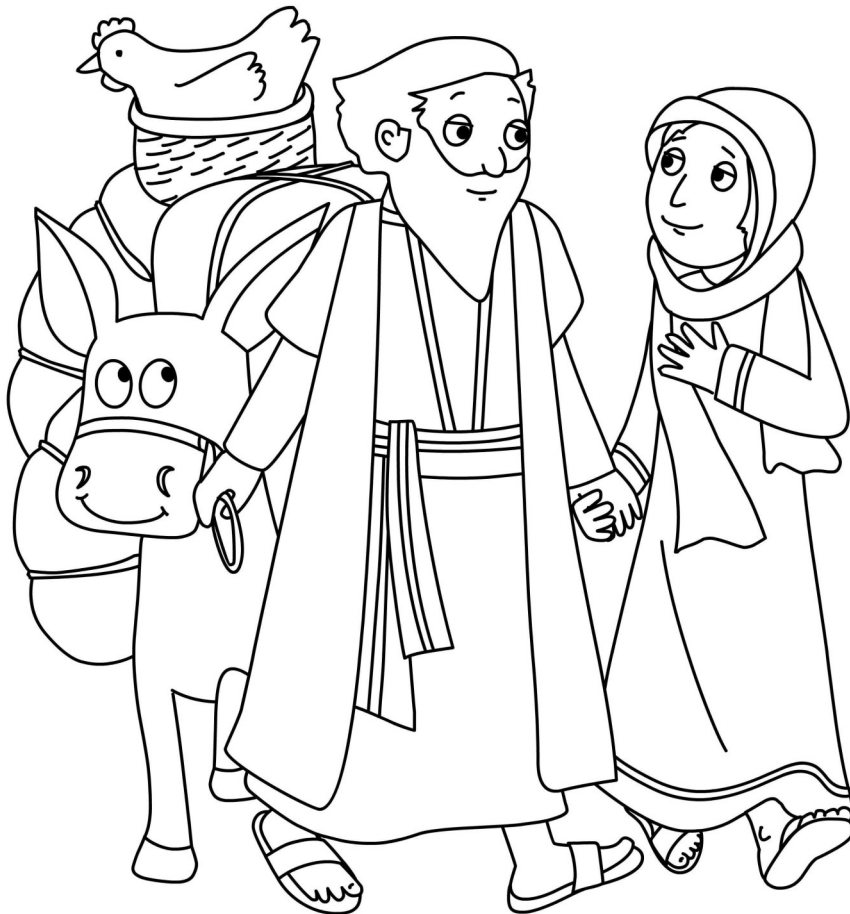


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GOD TOLD ABRAM

Genesis 12:4

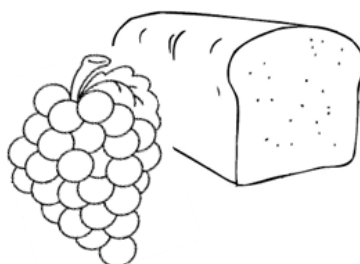


As you color the picture, talk about how God wants us to follow Him.
