


Draw a picture of something you need forgiveness for or help with. As you draw the picture, pour your heart out to God and quietly ask Him for forgiveness or help.

KEY VERSE: "When I was in trouble, I called out to the LORD. I cried to my God for help. From his temple he


heard my voice. My cry for help reached his ears." Psalm 18:6 (NIrV)
