# Activity Option 1

Cutout

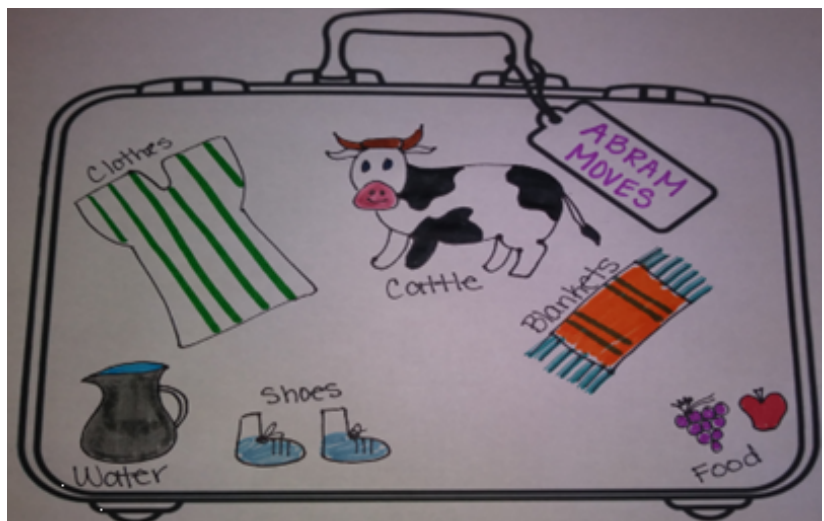
Glue Sticks

Give each child a suitcase printout and let them choose a few cutouts of Abrams belongings to glue to the bag. Talk with the children about what they would take with them if they had to pick up and move. Last give the children a Bible verse sticker to attach to their picture!

Give each child a blue sheet of paper, a green strip of paper and a tent cutout. Have them glue the green strip to the bottom of the blue paper to represent grass. Next have them glue the tent cutout on top of the grass. Have them color the cow and Abram cutout however they choose. They can also decorate the tent if they wish! Next have them glue Abram inside the tent and the cow on top the grass. Last have them draw some clouds in the sky if they want to and attach a bible verse sticker.
