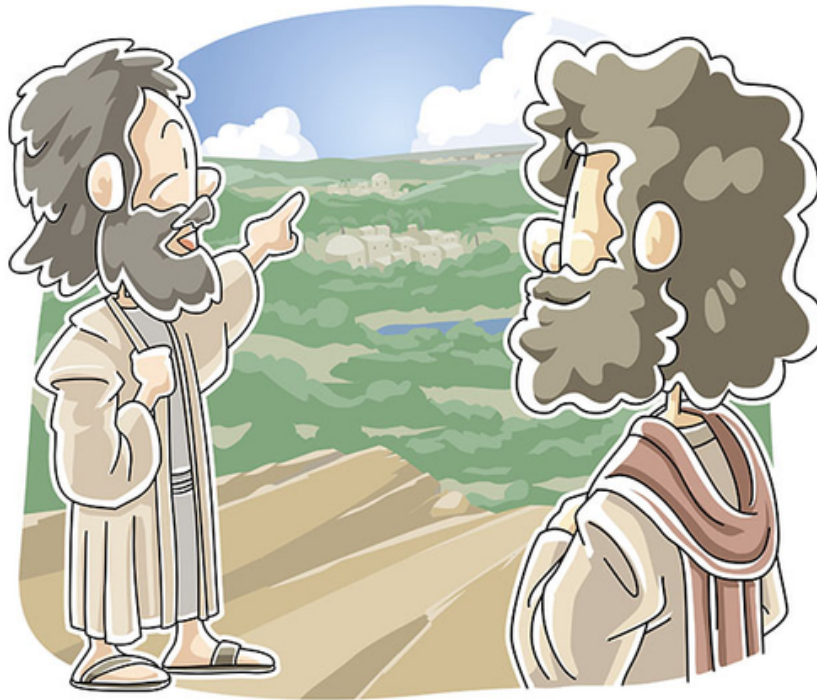

Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Abram and Lot

Verse: "I am God Almighty, walk before me and be blameless."

Genesis 17:1

Bible Point: God wants us to make good choices.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies:

Tree Branch
Picture

Stamp Pads

Bible Verse
Stickers

Today we learned how Abram and Lot had become very rich. They had lots of people that worked for them that took care of their animals and planting and harvesting their food. With so many people and animals they started arguing because it was getting hard for them to live together. Abram didn't want the workers to argue so he told Lot they needed to separate and that he could choose the land he wanted. God was so please with Abram that He promised Abram "I will give you all the land that you see."

Give each child a tree branch paper. Set out the stamp pads on the tables and have them use ONE finger to stamp leaves/flowers onto their branches. When they are done have them attach a Bible verse sticker. Make sure they wash their hands when they are done!

This picture is to remind us of all the land God promised Abram for making good choices. It is important that we make good choices too!



Activity Option 2

Give each child a map coloring sheet, an Abram cutout and a Lot cutout. Let them color each however they choose! Encourage them to draw sheep or cattle on their maps. When they are done they can either glue Abram and Lot onto their maps or fold them over and stand them up so they can move them around!
