Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Ruth Stays with Naomi

Verse: "Where you go, I will go." Ruth 1:6

Bible Point: God shows His love through others.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Ruth & Naomi
Sheets (Pre-
cut)

Crayons/
Markers

Glue Sticks

Craft Sticks

Today we learned about a girl named Ruth. Ruth decided to stay with her mother-in-law, Naomi, after their husbands had died. Ruth's husband was Naomi's son. Naomi had another son who was married to a girl named Orpah. This son also died. Naomi told Ruth and Orpah to go back to their hometowns and back to their families. Orpah went back, but Ruth wanted to stay and help Naomi. She wanted to live with her and serve God with her.

1. Give each child a pre-cut scene with Naomi and Orpah. Give them a pre-cut Ruth and have them color both however they would like.

2. Have them then glue Ruth to the craft stick using a glue stick.

3. Show them how to place the craft stick through the pre-cut slit in the scene of Naomi and Orpah.

4. The children should be able to slide the picture of Ruth towards Naomi, showing her desire to stay with her while the other daughter, Orpah is shown walking away.



Activity Option 2
