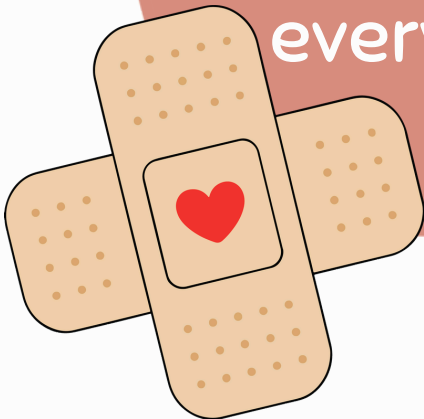




# Jesus Teaches about Helping

# Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Jesus Teaches about Helping

Verse: "Jesus answered...Obey my teaching." John 14:23

Bible Point: Jesus wants me to love everyone.

*The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

**Supplies:**

**Coloring  
Sheet**

**Donkey/  
Injured Man  
Cutout**

**Popsicle Stick**

**Tape**

**Crayons/  
Markers**

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

**Today we learned about how we can help others. We heard the story Jesus told about the Good Samaritan who helped someone who was injured by bandaging him up, putting him on his donkey and taking him to the inn to help him get better.**

**Today we are going to make a craft to remind us of this lesson and to remind us that we can help others too!**

Give each child a coloring sheet and a donkey cutout. Let them color them both however they choose. When they are done help them tape their donkey cutout onto a popsicle stick. Next have them insert their popsicle stick into the pre-cut slit in their coloring sheet. They can now move the stick back and forth to represent how the good Samaritan took the injured man to the inn.



# Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: Jesus Teaches about Helping

Verse: "Jesus answered...Obey my teaching." John 14:23

Bible Point: Jesus wants me to love everyone.

**Today we learned about how we can help others. When we help people we show them God's love.**

**Have the child write their name on their paper. Help the child trace their hand on the paper. Give the child stickers and markers/crayons and have them decorate their hand however they would like!**

**This craft is designed to help the children think about their hands being like Jesus' hands. Jesus helped others, He served the hungry, sick and poor. We can be like Jesus too. We can listen to our parents, teachers and obey them. Or we can help others who need our help like the good samaritan did in our Bible story today!!**
