Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Jesus Teaches about Sharing

Verse: "Jesus answered...Obey my teaching." John 14:23

Bible Point: Jesus wants me to love everyone.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

*Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned about a greedy farmer who did not want to share. He could not have any friends because all he really cared about was himself. The greedy farmer certainly did not want to share with those in need. How sad for him. He missed out on the blessing of sharing and making others feel loved and happy.

Today we are going to glue on gems to our cross to show that God does not want to be greedy with money or food like in the story we read today about the brothers. We must be rich in God and our faith only.

Give each child a cross cut out, some glue, and gems. Help them if needed to glue the gems on their cross. Be sure to reiterate the symbolism of the gems and why we must be rich in towards God and faith.



Activity Option 2

Hand out the roof cutout, the wall cutout, the little windows, big windows, and glue. Help the kids glue the correct pieces on and fold them accordingly to make the barn. (The phrase might still be seen when the barn doors are closed but that is okay).
