

Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: Jesus as a Boy

Verse: "For my eyes have seen your salvation!" Luke 2:30

Bible Point: Jesus is the special Son of God.

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

Supplies:

**Coloring
Sheet**

**Popsicle
Sticks
(2 per child)**

**Colors/
Markers**

Glue

Yarn

Say the words in **BOLD*

Today we learned that when Jesus was 12 he went to Jerusalem with his parents to Celebrate Passover. Who remembers what Passover means? (allow for response) When Mary and Joseph began walking home with a large group of people they thought Jesus was with them. When they got home they realized Jesus was not with them. They looked for Jesus for 3 days before they found Jesus in the temple. Jesus said to his parents "didn't you know I would be in my fathers house?" Jesus pleased God by talking to the temple teachers about God and by obeying His parents.

Today we are going to make a scroll to remind us that Jesus teaches about God! **Give each child a coloring sheet and let them color with crayons/markers however they choose. When they are done have them glue a popsicle stick onto the top AND bottom of the coloring sheet. Help them roll their sheet up and tie it with a piece of yarn!**



Activity Option 2



Today we are going to make a temple to represent where Jesus was when his parents thought he was lost. Give each child a solid sheet of paper, a bible verse cutout, a temple cutout and a Jesus as a boy cutout. Let them color their temple and Jesus cutout however they choose. Help them glue their temple to the solid sheet of paper but make sure they DO NOT glue the doors to the temple. Next have them open their temple doors and glue their Jesus cutout inside. Lastly have them glue their Bible verse strip to the top of the page!
