## ACTIVITY:

Talk to your child about the Bible. Talk about how it is God's Word. We read it so we can learn about God and share with others.

Talk to your child about being sick. Use a toy stethoscope or something similar to go along with this activity. Educate your child on what a stethoscope does and who uses one. Let your child take turns using the stethoscope to listen to their heart and each other's.

## PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.  
Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy. You may pray yourself or use the following prayer.

Prayer: "Dear God, thank you for this day. Thanking for taking such good care of us. Help us to remember all the ways you take care of us. We love you. In Jesus' name, Amen."

While singing with your baby/toddler, rock them back and forth and interact with them.

## BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

### Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Luke 8.

"Jairus was a daddy, and his little girl was very sick. What do you do when you're sick? Can you show me? Do you lie down and hold your tummy?

Do you sit on Mommy's or Daddy's lap?

Sometimes Mommy gives you medicine.

Sometimes Daddy takes you to the doctor. What does the doctor do? Does the doctor look in your mouth? Does the doctor look in your ears? Show me your ears. The doctors couldn't help Jairus' little girl get better. But Jairus knew that Jesus

could help his little girl. Jesus held the little girl's hand and said, "Little girl, get up!" And she did! The little girl was alive and well! She was happy, too! Her mommy and daddy were happy.

Everyone was so happy! Jesus cared for the Jairus' daughter just as He cares for you today.

TIME TO TALK:

As you change diapers, wash hands, rock, play with, and console your baby/toddler take time to talk about the Bible story.

AFFIRMING STATEMENTS:




