

Jesus As a Boy

For these crafts, talk to your child about the lesson. Talk about how Jesus was just a young boy but knew God was His Father and how he went to the temple to worship Him. Once your child is done with their craft, end in prayer.

All you need for this craft is:

- coloring sheet below
- two jumbo craft sticks
- glue
- crayons
- yarn or string



Glue one craft stick on the top, the other on the bottom, color, roll, and tie with string or yarn. End in prayer and thank God for the Bible so we can learn more about God just like they did in the temple with their scrolls.

2nd Craft- Jesus Sensory Bottle

For this craft you will need:

- an empty, dry, clean water bottle.
- a funnel (A paper made one will work just as well.)
- enough rice to fill each water bottle about 3/4 full
- miniature picture of Jesus and label (attached below)
- tape
- a variety of small objects such as foamie shapes, beads, buttons, pom-poms, sequins, jewels, etc.
- a hot glue



Use a funnel to pour the rice into the water bottle. Use a hot glue gun to glue the cap to the bottle. Tape the label to the bottle. Shake and mix up the contents of the bottle. End in prayer.
