# Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: The Unforgiving Servant

Verse: “Jesus answered, ‘Obey my teaching.’” John 14:23

**Worksheet**


**Paint/Water**

**Today we learned about a king and a servant. The king forgave the servant of a large debt, but the servant did NOT forgive a man who owed him a small amount. He even put this man in jail! Let's make a craft that shows how we can forgive others because Jesus died to forgive us!**

Give each child an Unforgiving Servant cardstock worksheet, Q-Tips, and cups of water. Allow the children to paint the picture however they would like as you read the above summary of the Bible story to them. Remind the children how important it is to forgive others because we have been forgiven, and it pleases God.



# Activity Option 2

**Hand each child a pre-cut heart and an "I can forgive" sheet. Have the children color the heart if they would like. Have each child think of someone they know that they could forgive of anything, even if it seems small. Perhaps they can think of someone they **WOULD** forgive if they ever needed to. Ask them to draw this person in the square on the worksheet. Read the verse to them again as they are working!**
