# Activity Option 1

Bible Focus: The Road to Emmaus

Verse: "Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God." John 20:31

Bible Point: I can tell everyone that Jesus is alive

*The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

## Supplies:

**2 Cardstock Pieces: The Three Men and the Road/Town**

**Craft Stick**

**Crayons & Markers**

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned about a mysterious stranger who appeared to two disciples while they were walking the road to the town of Emmaus. The two disciples did not know that they were actually talking to Jesus Himself until later.

We are going to color and put together a craft that shows the two disciples walking and talking with Jesus on the road to Emmaus.

**DIRECTIONS:**

1. Have the children color the two cardstock pieces of their craft.
2. Using a glue stick, have them glue the three men (2 disciples and Jesus) to a craft stick.
3. Show them how to place the craft stick with the 3 men into the slit of the other piece of cardstock.
4. They can move the 3 men back and forth to pretend they are "walking" on the road to Emmaus!



# Activity Option 2

Bible Focus: The Road to Emmaus

Verse: “Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God.” John 20:31

Bible Point: I can tell everyone that Jesus is alive

*The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

## Supplies:

Sticky Cross

Tissue Paper

Two pieces of paper: “Road to Emmaus” and Scripture Reference

Glue Stick

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

Today we learned about a mysterious stranger who appeared to two disciples while they were walking the road to the town of Emmaus. The two disciples did not know that they were actually talking to Jesus Himself until later.

Let’s create a cross reminder of Jesus’ death and resurrection-the reason He was able to appear on the road to Emmaus with the two disciples to remind them of God’s plan.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Have the children peel off the yellow paper from the cross to reveal the sticky side.
2. Have them stick colorful pieces of tissue paper on the sticky side of the cross to resemble a stained glass window.
3. Lastly, using a glue stick, have them glue the two pieces of paper to the middle of the cross that say, “Road to Emmaus” and “Luke 24:13-32”.
