# Activity Option 1

**Bible Focus: Paul Helps People Follow Jesus**

**Verse: “Tell the Good News to everyone!” Mark 16:15**

**Bible Point: : We can tell about Jesus**

The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.

## Supplies Needed:

Boat Coloring Sheet

Markers

Q-tips

Watercolor Paint

Paper Towels

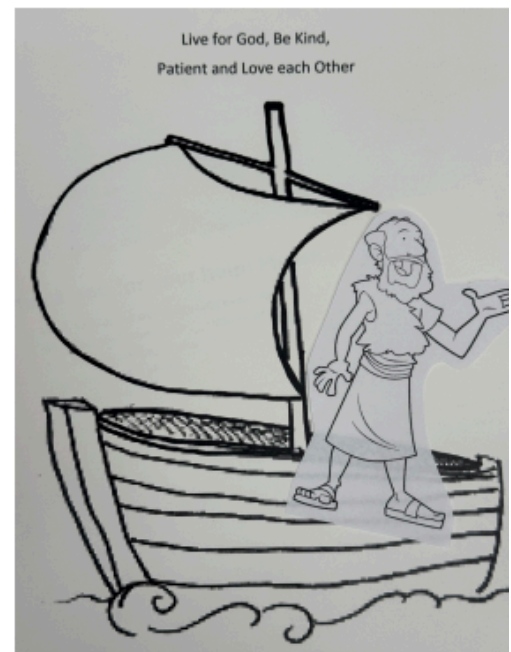
Water Cups

Today we learned about how Paul told the good news to people who did not believe in Jesus. However, these people had Paul arrested and put on a ship and sailed him to Rome! Paul was guarded by a soldier all day every day to make sure he did not escape. Paul would write letters to Christians telling them to live for God, be kind, patient and love each other. Paul also taught Christians to forgive each other because Jesus forgave us of our sins. People should forgive like Jesus does.

Today we are going to paint a ship to remind us of how people who did not believe in Jesus shipped Paul to Rome.

Give each child a coloring sheet and a cutout of Paul. Let them color and glue Paul onto the boat. Then, have them water paint their picture however they choose.



# Activity Option 2

### Supplies Needed:

Solid Paper

Mailbox Cutout

Popsicle Stick

2 Envelope Cutouts

Bible Verse Cutout

Give each child a colored sheet of paper, a mailbox cutout, 2 envelope cutouts, a bible verse cutout and a popsicle stick. Have them color the mailbox and envelopes however they want! When they are done have them glue the stick onto the paper then glue the mailbox cutout on top of that. Next let them glue their envelopes onto the paper along with the Bible verse cutout wherever they choose. Remind them that this craft is to help us remember how Paul would write letters to Christians.
